## **BACKGROUND**

The attached PowerPoint dated October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2011 will be presented at the People's Assembly and Citizen feedback will be sought.

Two motions will be presented for consideration of the Assembly. The first is procedural only:

“BE IT RESOLVED to receive the PowerPoint entitled, “Spring 2012 Legislation” presented to the People's Assembly on November 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011.”

The second motion seeks approval of the Assembly for an amendment to the Citizenship Declaration.

“BE IT RESOLVED to approve amendments to the *Citizenship and Treaty Enrolment Act* retroactive to April 1, 2011 which make the wording of the Citizenship Declaration contained in the Schedule to that Act substantively the same as the HUU-ay-aht Oath contained in the Schedule to the *Code of Conduct and Conflict of Interest Act*, and further to recommend that Executive Council ensure that the remaining steps to enact the amendments and bring them into force are completed by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012. ”
