

TRIBUNAL DIRECTIVE #2011-3

USUAL TIME PERIODS FOR TRIBUNAL MATTERS

November 28, 2011

This Directive is issued pursuant to *Tribunal Act*, s.33(1) and *Administrative Tribunals Act* (British Columbia), s.12:

- The usual time period for completing an application and for completing procedural steps within an application may be determined from times specified in applicable Huu-ay-aht Legislation, including the *Tribunal Act*, and the *Tribunal Rules of Practice and Procedure*. Where not so specified, any procedural step to be taken by the Tribunal will usually be taken within two weeks.
- The usual time period within which the Tribunal's final decision and reasons are to be released after the hearing of an application is completed will be one month.
