BACKGROUND

The PowerPoint entitled “Tribunal Decision #2012 -001” and a handout setting out the Tribunal’s findings were distributed on November 1st, 2012 and will be presented at the People’s Assembly. Citizen feedback will be sought.

- (c) recommend that Executive Council ensure the remaining steps to enact all these recommendations are completed as soon as possible and by no later than March 31st, 2013.”
