Motion

WHEREAS:

1. Citizen Development Regulation (the “Proposed Agenda Item”) were not included on the proposed agenda for the January 9, 2013 special meeting of Executive Council; and
2. Executive Council is obligated to conduct itself in a manner consistent with “open, accountable, transparent and effective government” and Huu-ay-aht law under section 50 of the *Government Act*, which includes public notice in advance of the matters to be dealt with by Executive Council under s. 45(2) of the *Government Act*; and considering that
3. Time is of the essence.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. In the circumstances it is reasonably justified to add the Proposed Agenda Item to the Agenda for the January 9, 2013 Executive Council meeting;
2. The Proposed Agenda items are hereby added to the Agenda for the January 9, 2013, 2012 Executive Council meeting; and
3. Executive Council approves the Agenda for the January 9, 2013 Executive Council meeting as amended.
