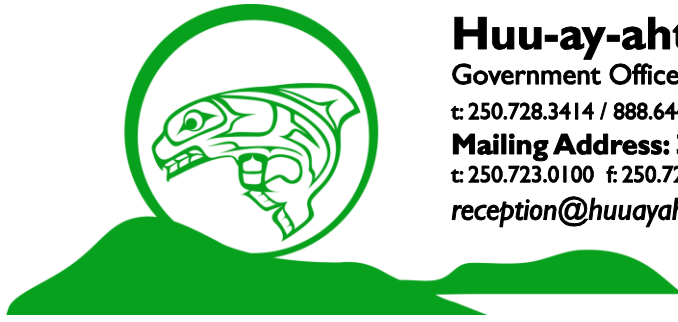
- Lands and Natural Resources

- For the most part, budgets, acts, regulations and the strategic plans are ready for introduction and reading to the legislation
- Bamfield Huu-ay-aht Community forest had their AGM and Huu-ay-aht's representative are Jeff Cook, Charlie Clappis, Stefan Ochman.
- As of April 01st. 2013, we will be taking over our education.
- Had a restorative justice circle over an illegal elk kill. The hunter had 3-4 conditions that he has to complete.
- Esk'etemc FN was very happy with their visit and presentations we made
- John Rich gave us an overview of the Tribunal proceedings and report on the specific claims.
- There is concerns with the USMA programme and we are in the process of setting up a meeting with them.
- I attended two community round meetings. We had two citizens attend in Nanaimo and thirteen citizens and two guests attend in Anacla.
- Toured a building on 2nd. and Argyle St. as a potential purchase investment.(office)
- Have a couple of investment proposals come to Council

Progress on Key Initiatives:

- Meeting with SK group (Korean) went well but I don't foresee any action until after the provincial election.
- We are getting closer to an agreement with BMSC on the treatment and outfall portion of the forcemain.
- Draft of the local education agreement is almost complete.
