- The Federal cabinet has not yet appointed their official representative to the Joint Fisheries Committee. This is problematic as we can't make decisions at the JFC meetings.
- In addition, they have not appointed the aboriginal representative to the Pacific Salmon Commission either.

- Economic Development / HDC - Accessing funds for investment in future projects is a strategic concern for the committee and the HDC boards. It will be necessary that we have a discussion during capital budgeting regarding Executive Council's plan for economic development
