Issue

In 2012 after being empty for a year and scheduled for demolition there was an idea to donate the old office building to the sports group in Anacla. The building sits on the same lot as the sports field and there is currently no storage space for any sports equipment other than resident's back rooms.

Background

In February of 2012 the Committee was heavily in favor of the donation of the old office building to the sports and recreation group if they formed a non-profit society and Executive Council wrote a letter of support. It has been a year in the making but both are now done.

Discussion

On February 8th 2013, a Certificate of Incorporation was received by the Huu-ay-aht Active Living Society. Once the building is signed over then the Society would be able to discuss the lease agreement with the Government and the much needed work on the building could begin. There has been community members' inquiring about how they could help the renovations to the building. This will have a huge positive impact on the Anacla community.
