BUILDING SERVICE WORKER

The Building Service Worker program is designed for individuals seeking an opportunity to enter the building service field.. Training is designed for individuals with limited experience, who have a desire to work in the field and gain the fundamental skills to pursue entry level positions in the industry. Graduates of the program may secure employment in entry-level custodial positions in school districts, hospitals, other institutions, hotels, offices, and industrial settings.

The program is delivered over four consecutive weeks, full time and is comprised of theory and in the field practical applications. The program has limited seating due to the applied nature of the training.

What will participants study?

The program consists of the following modules:

- Foundation Skills Training
- WHMIS
- Occupational First Aid Level 1
- Building Service Worker Level 1
- Building Service Worker Level 2: Hard Floor Care
- Building Service Worker Level 3: Carpet Care
- Building Service Worker Practicum
- Transition to Employment

Eligibility:

This Employment Skills Access (ESA) program is designed to assist unemployed, or low skilled individuals gain employment. All tuition and books are included for participants who meet the specific ESA eligibility criteria.

You **may be eligible** for entry if you are:

- Unemployed **AND** not collecting Employment Insurance (EI) **AND** have not been associated with a regular EI claim in the past three years or maternity/parental claim in the past five years.
