The Legislature enacts as follows:

Amendment

- 1 The *Government Act* is amended:
 - (a) in section 39(2(a)), by striking out the words "Huu-ay-aht citizen" and substituting the word "individual".
 - (b) in section 39, by adding the following subsection:
 - "(3.1) When considering applications for appointment to the position of Speaker by candidates who meet the requirements of section (2), Executive Council shall give preference to any candidate who is a Huu-ay-aht citizen."

Commencement

2 This act comes into force by resolution of Executive Council.
