

Residential Lease Regulation Amendment Regulation, 2015

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Amendments

- 1 The *Residential Lease Regulation*, HFNR 3/2012 is amended:
 - (a) in section 11 (1) by striking out the words “chair means chair of the tribunal” and substituting the words “Speaker means the Speaker appointed under section 39 of the Government Act or the acting Speaking appointed under section 41 of the Government Act”,
 - (b) in section 11(2) through 11(8) by striking out the word “chair” each time it appears and substituting the word “Speaker”,
 - (c) in section 11(4)(a) by striking out the words “tribunal member” and substituting the words “member of the Huu-ay-aht Council designated by the Chief Councillor”,
 - (d) in section 11(4)(b) by striking out the words “other tribunal members” and substituting “trusted and respected Huu-ay-aht citizens designated by the Chief Councillor”,
 - (e) in section 12 by striking out the word “chair” and substituting the word “Speaker”.

Commencement

- 2 This regulation comes into force on the date of its enactment by Executive Council.

Consolidation

- 3 The Law Clerk is directed to consolidate the *Residential Lease Regulation*, HFNR 3/2012 to include the amendments contained in this regulation.
