INFRASTRUCTURE POLICY AMENDMENT REGULATION, 2013

Government infrastructure

- 1** *Section 1 of the Infrastructure Policy Regulation, HFNR 10/2011 is amended by striking out the definition “government infrastructure” and substituting:*

“government infrastructure” means a physical asset with

- (a) an expected useful life of at least 5 years based on the design of the asset, and
- (b) a capital cost of \$ 50 000 or more;

Commencement

- 2** (1) Section 1 is deemed to have been continuously in force from April 1, 2012.
- (2) Subsection (1) is retroactive to the extent necessary to give full force and effect to its provisions and must not be construed as lacking retroactive effect in relation to any matter because it makes no specific reference to that matter.
