The EMR course offers fundamental medical training for anyone entering the health care field.

This course focuses on the skills needed to respond to trauma and medical emergencies.

Training also includes the fundamentals of anatomy, physiology, pathophysiology, pharmacology, and medical terminology.

The Emergency Medical Responder course is a prerequisite course for the Primary Care Paramedic Program.

- Prepare you for further education or a career within the health care industry
- Provide you with an Emergency Medical Responder certificate and acquire provincial licensing through EMALB.
- Provide you with cardio-pulmonary resuscitation certification level 'C' –Health Care Provider (CPR-HCP)
