****Please ensure your children are dressed warm for walking outside and skating (age 6 and up)**

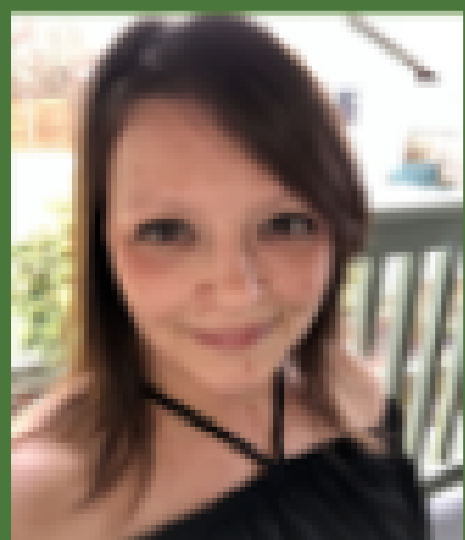
****For children age 0 – 3 Parents are responsible in providing formula and diapers, wipes, extra clothing for your child for this day.**

****If your child has ANY food allergies, please pack snacks and a lunch for your child to bring to child minding.**



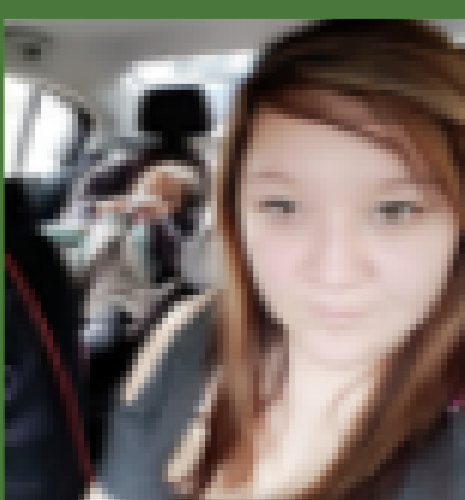
Meet Rhonda van Adrichem, Coordinator
