



HUU-AY-AHT COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY PLAN

Due to Covid-19, we temporarily put the development of our Comprehensive Community Plan on hold. Now, we're ready to re-engage with citizens to build a vision for our future and outline a way to get there.

WHAT IS A COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY PLAN (CCP)?

It is *comprehensive*, it will look at everything that is important to HUU-ay-aht: our land, our water, and our people and more. It is about *community*: it will be developed by the community, for the community. It is a *plan*: we will imagine our potential, ground it in the possible, and create a plan to make it all happen.

PHASE 2

Over 160 citizens joined conversations about what would make HUU-ay-aht an even better community. We heard lots of ideas about increasing housing options within the hahuuti, increasing language programming, and furthering cultural opportunities for citizens in all communities. Phase 2 involves evaluating priorities and assessing feasible timelines for different ideas. Future development possibilities in Anacla, including what it would take to help Anacla reach its full potential, is a key consideration.
