## Ḥawiiḥ Council

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given that:

Kenneth Johnson has made an application to the Ḥawiiḥ Council for a determination that he does not pose an unreasonable risk to public safety.

On June 25, 2019, Mr. Johnson was convicted of the following offences:

- aggravated assault (*Criminal Code*, s. 268(2))
- assault (*Criminal Code*, s. 266)
- assault causing bodily harm (*Criminal Code*, s. 267(b))

As a result of these convictions, an exclusion order was issued against Mr. Johnson prohibiting him from being on Huu-ay-aht treaty lands.

The Ḥawiiḥ Council will be conducting a hearing to decide whether to keep the order in place, vary the terms of the order or rescind the order. This may involve imposing conditions under which Mr. Johnson may be allowed to return to treaty lands.

The following people have the right to participate in the hearing:

- Mr. Johnson
- Any victims of the crimes giving rise to the order
- Mr. Johnson's family and dependents

In addition, the Ḥawiiḥ Council may also allow others to participate in the hearing.
