## Hāwiih Council

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given that:

Darin Martin has made an application to the Hāwiih Council for a determination that he does not pose an unreasonable risk to public safety and that the exclusion order issued against him should be rescinded.

On January 19, 2022, Mr. Martin was convicted of the offence of assault under section 266 of the *Criminal Code*.

As a result of this conviction, an exclusion order was issued against Mr. Martin prohibiting him from being on Huu-ay-aht treaty lands. The order has not yet gone into effect.

The Hāwiih Council will be conducting a hearing to decide whether to rescind the order as Mr. Martin has asked. They may also decide keep the order in place, or to vary it. This may involve imposing conditions under which Mr. Martin may be allowed to remain on treaty lands.

The following people have the right to participate in the hearing:

- Mr. Martin
- Any victims of the crimes giving rise to the order
- Mr. Martin's family and dependents

The Hāwiih Council may also decide to allow others to participate.
