Attendance at the People's Assembly Policy

- With the recent People's Assembly that happened in November 2023, citizens were asked to review the People's Assembly Policy during registration.
- Please note that as per section 2(1) of the People's Assembly Policy Huu-ay-aht First Nations, "arrange for satellite locations in areas that are accessible to most citizens and/or pay the travel and accommodation expenses for citizens needing to travel to the location of the People's Assembly."
- Section 3, Requirement to Attend Voting Sessions, "In order to be eligible to have their travel expenses, including accommodation, paid for by the Huu-ay-aht, citizens must be present at all voting sessions of the People's Assembly in respect of which those expenses were incurred.
- and Section 4, Failure to Attend Voting Sessions of the Policy, "Where a citizen's travel expenses have been paid for by the Huu-ay-aht and the citizen fails to attend all voting sessions of the People's Assembly, the amounts paid by the Huu-ay-aht on behalf of that citizen will become a debt payable to the Huu-ay-aht First Nations (the "debt")
- If a Debt is accrued the Nation must follow the Distribution Administration Policies section 3.3 (b) Payment of Debt to the Huu-ay-aht First Nations " Unless directed otherwise by Executive Council motion, the Director must withhold the Distribution Shares of a Citizen with an unpaid Debt to the Huu-ay-aht First Nations and the Director will apply toward the Citizen's Debt the Distribution Shares of the Citizen until that Debt is paid in full.
