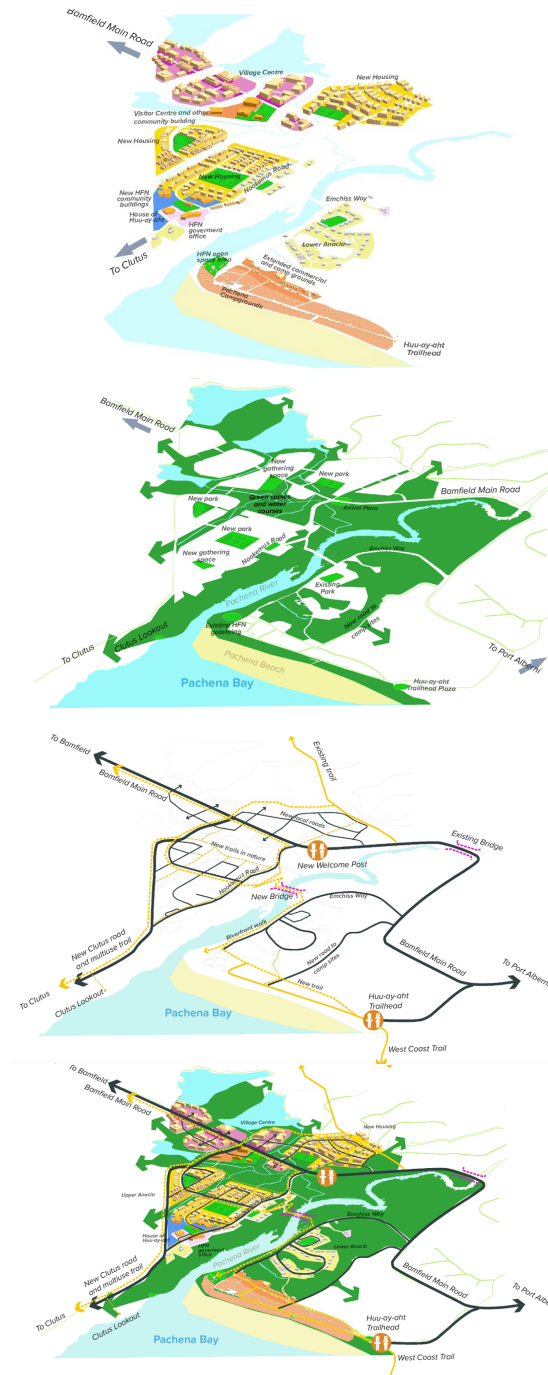

What is a Framework Plan?

A Framework Plan is a long term vision to guide physical change and development over a 20-30 year horizon.

The Plan identifies land uses, open spaces and mobility networks within the ḥahuuŭi. Below is a visualization of how the layers of a Framework Plan guide the physical evolution of an area.

(Places to live, work, learn, and gather, etc.)

Open Spaces

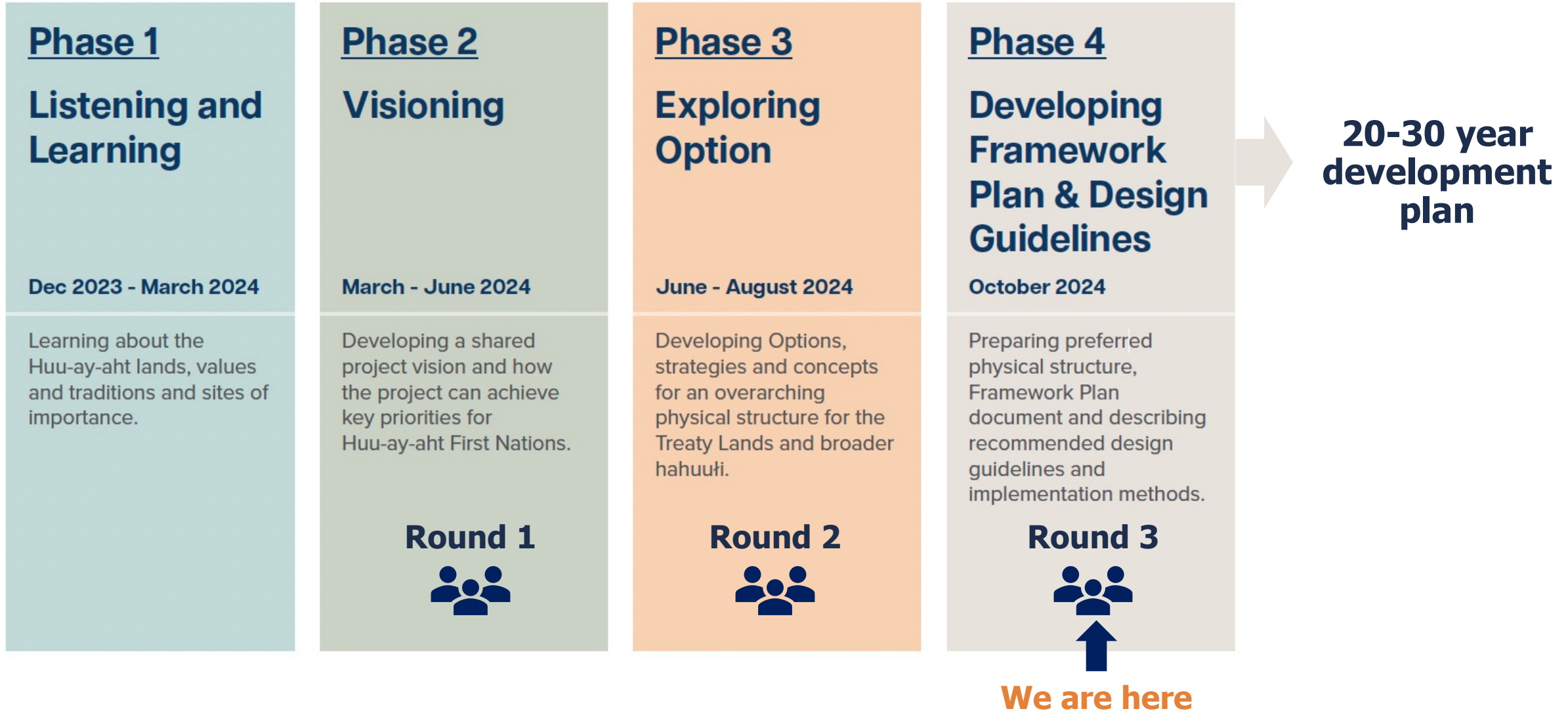
(Parks, beaches, and open spaces, etc.)

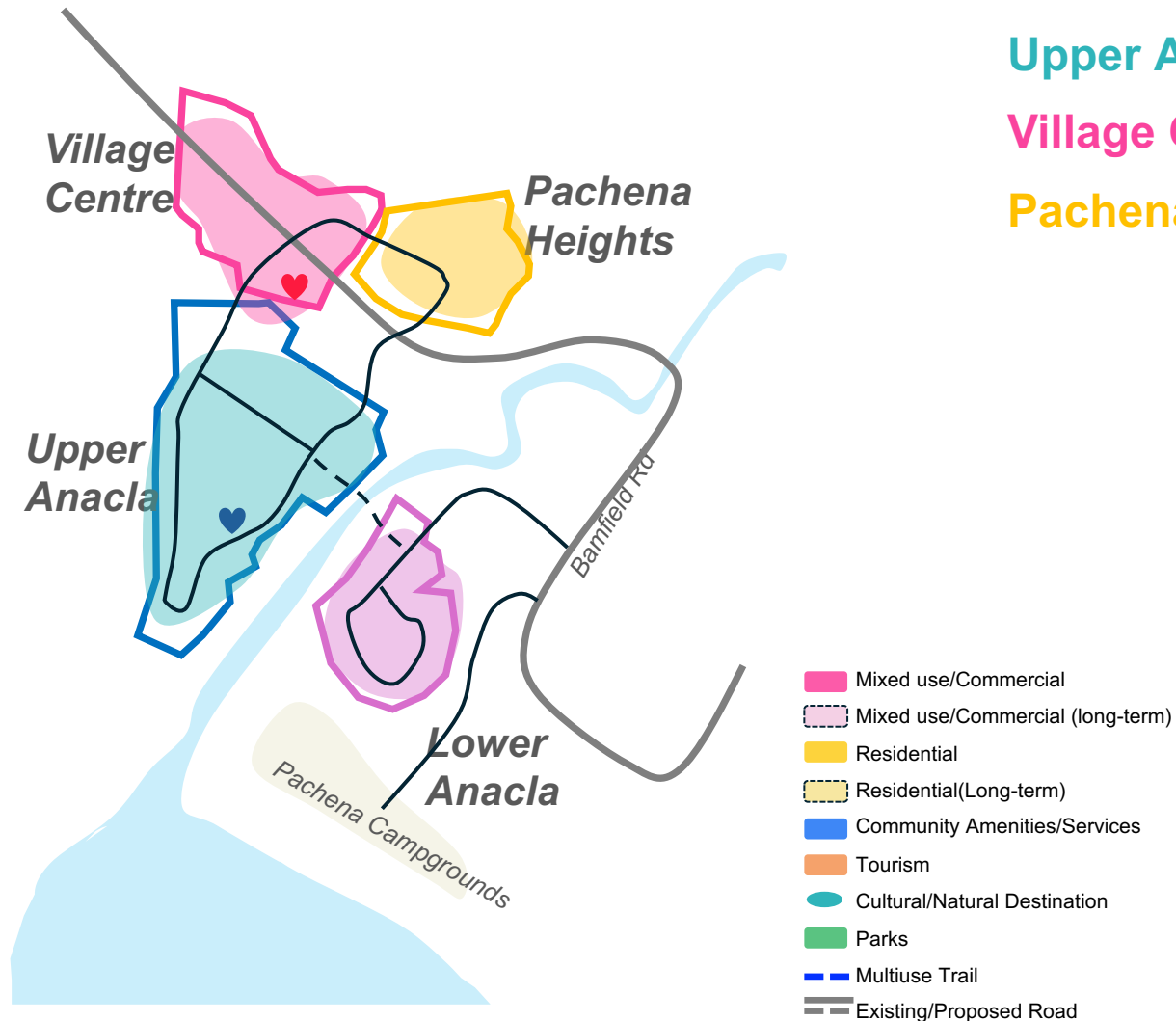

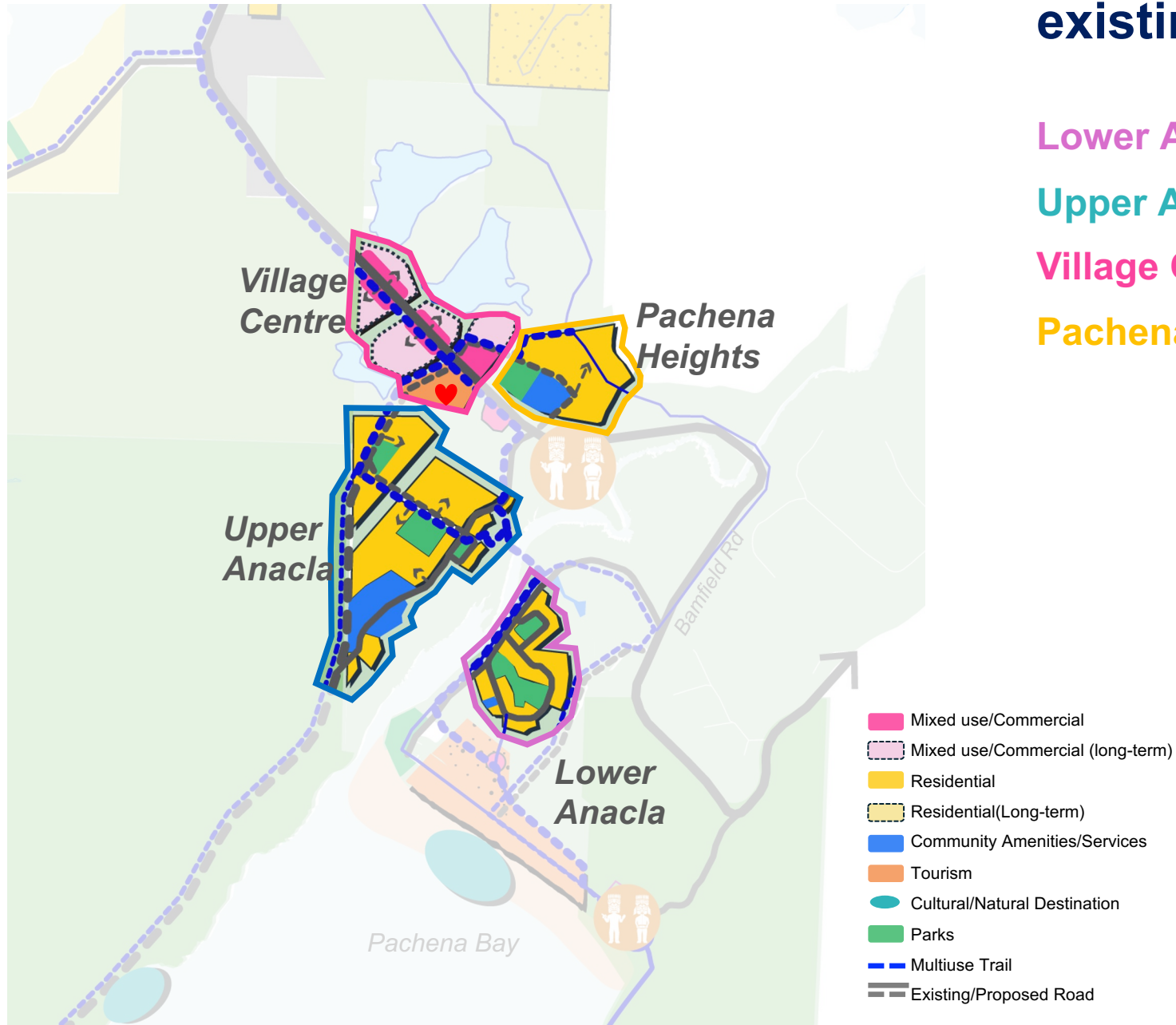

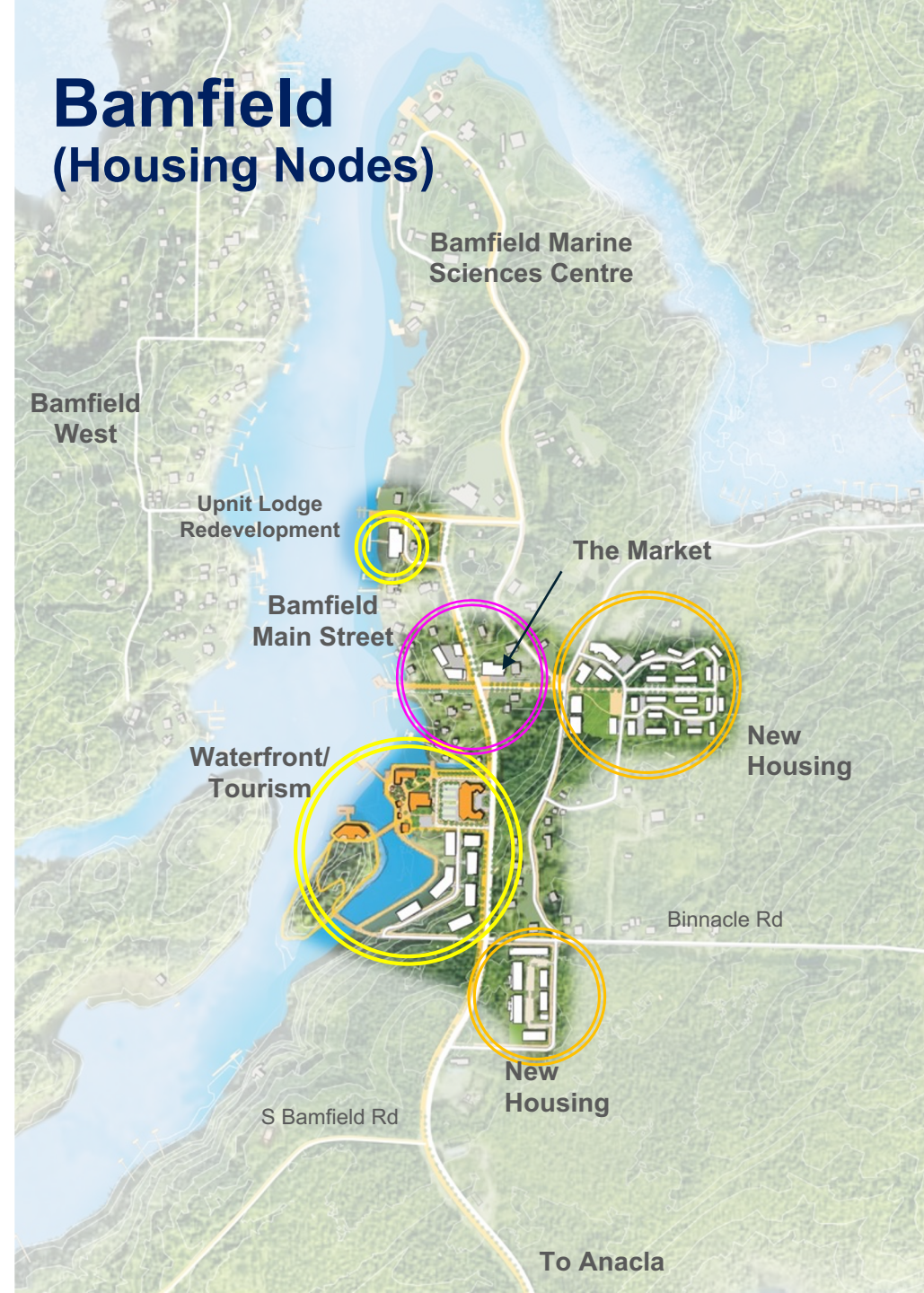

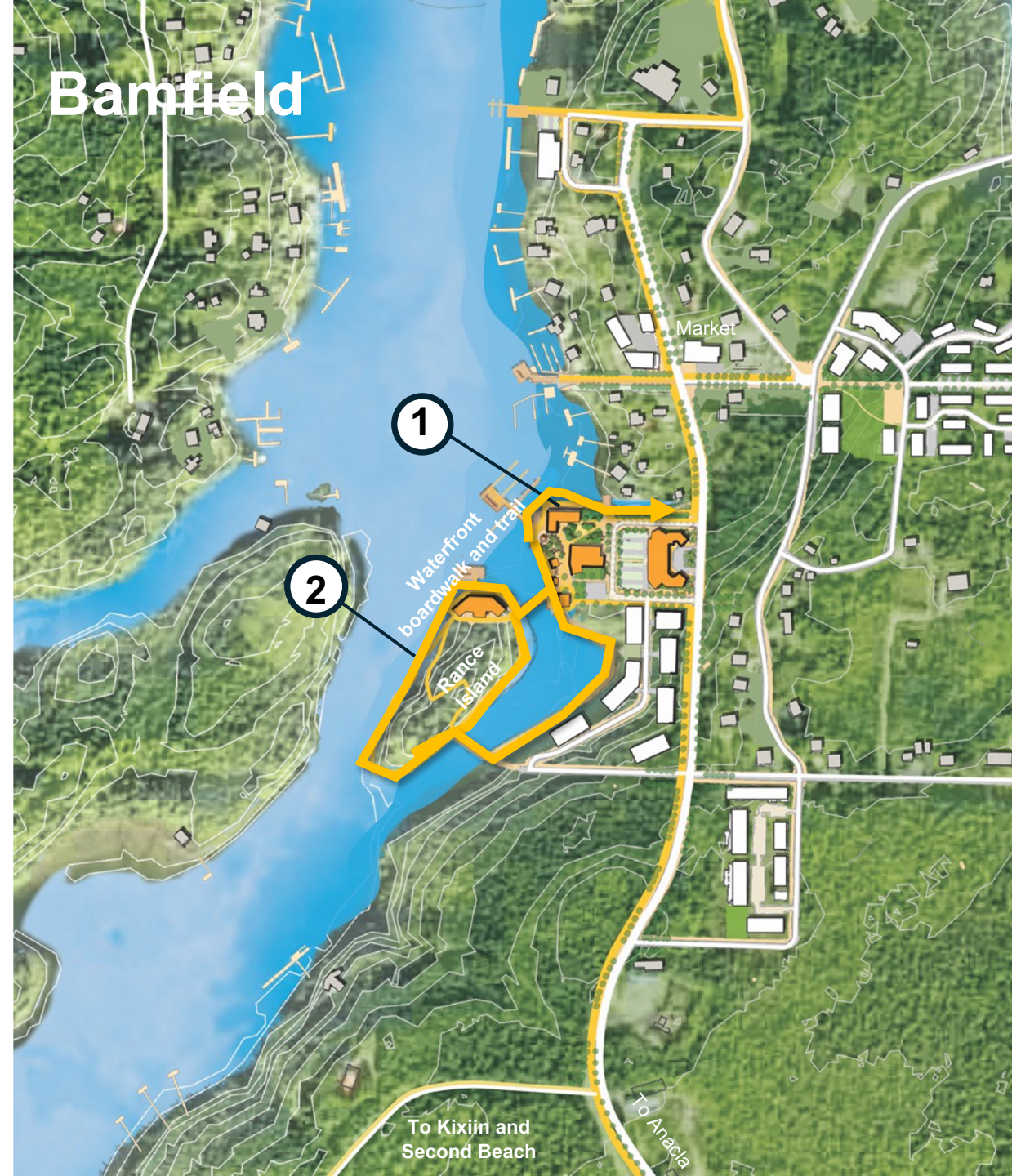

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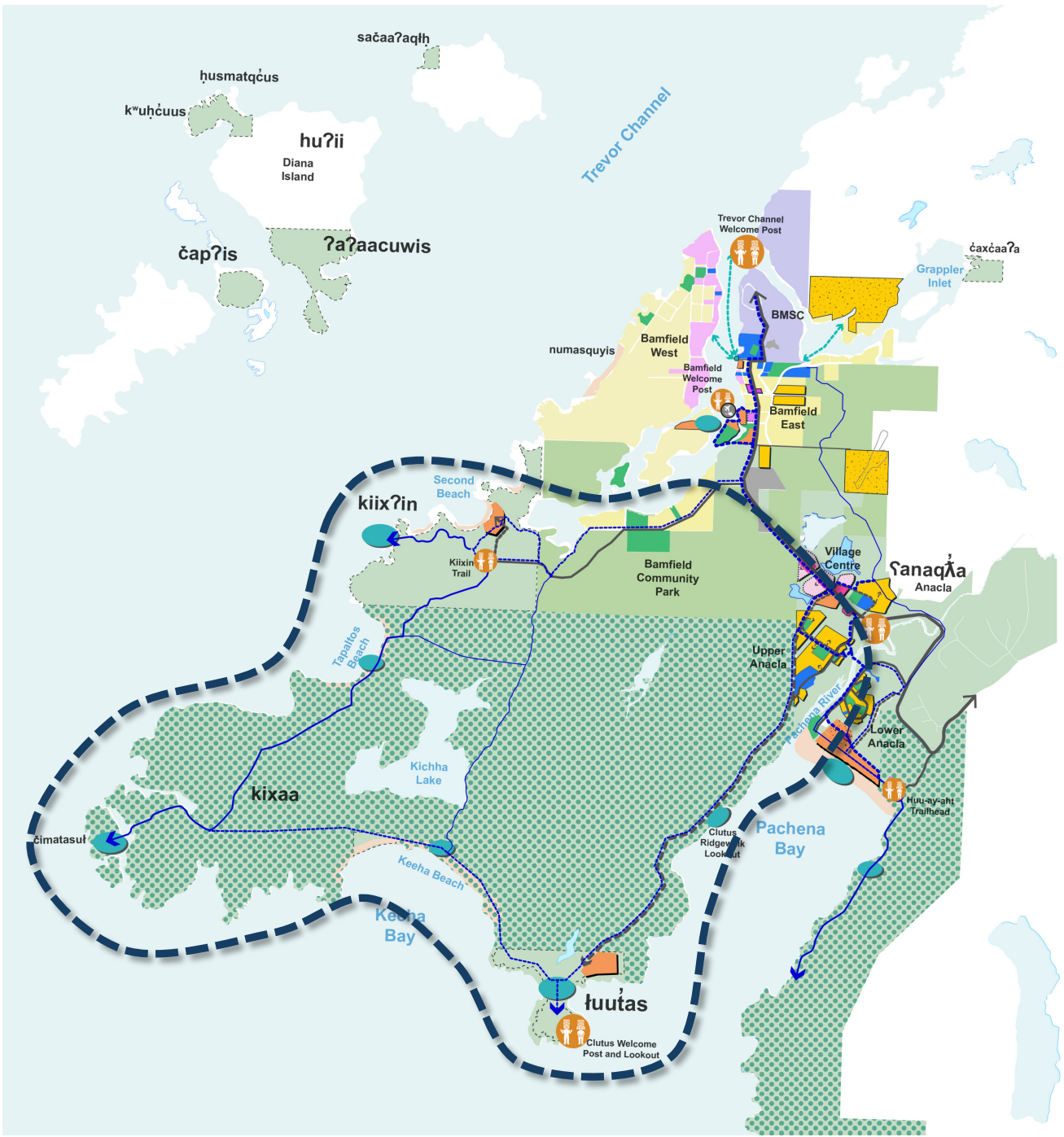

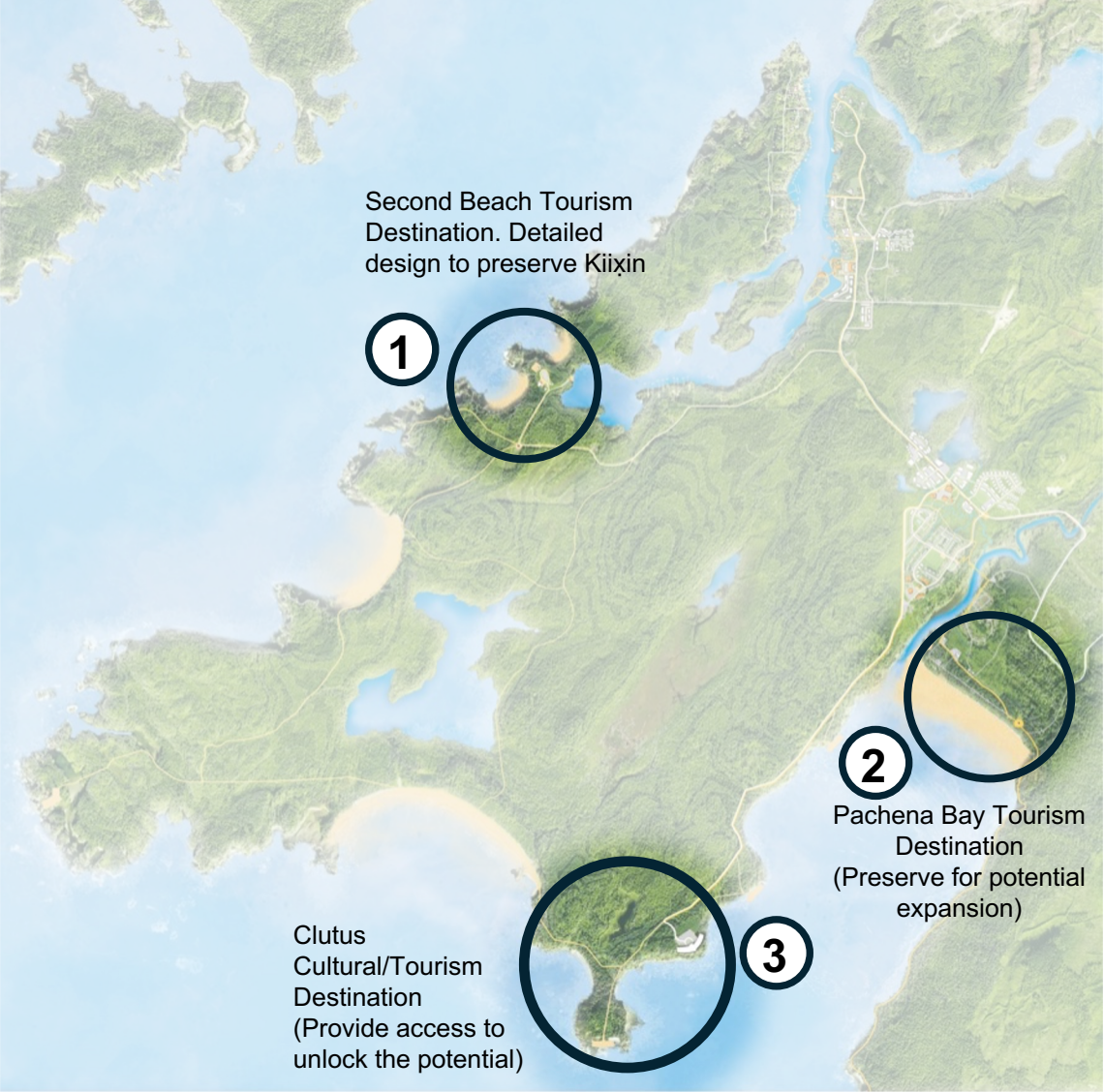
