
To the Pacheedaht First Nation and all interested parties,

We, the Southern Nuu-chah-nulth Nations, write to express our unequivocal support for the Pacheedaht First Nation and their formal request for all third-party blockaders to stand down and leave their traditional territory. The sovereignty and self-determination of Indigenous Nations are paramount. We stand in solidarity with the Pacheedaht as they assert their right to govern their lands and resources according to their own laws, customs, and stewardship principles. True respect for Indigenous authority means honouring the decisions made by the Nation itself, not by outside groups who seek to impose their own agenda.


The continued presence of uninvited protesters undermines the essential work of reconciliation and creates division where unity is needed. Like the Pacheedaht, our Nations are deeply committed to the sustainable and holistic management of our lands for the benefit of our people and future generations. Progress cannot be achieved through conflict and interference. We call for all external parties to respect the wishes of the Pacheedaht First Nation, cease their disruptive activities, and respect the Nation's requirement for blockaders to exit their territory.






