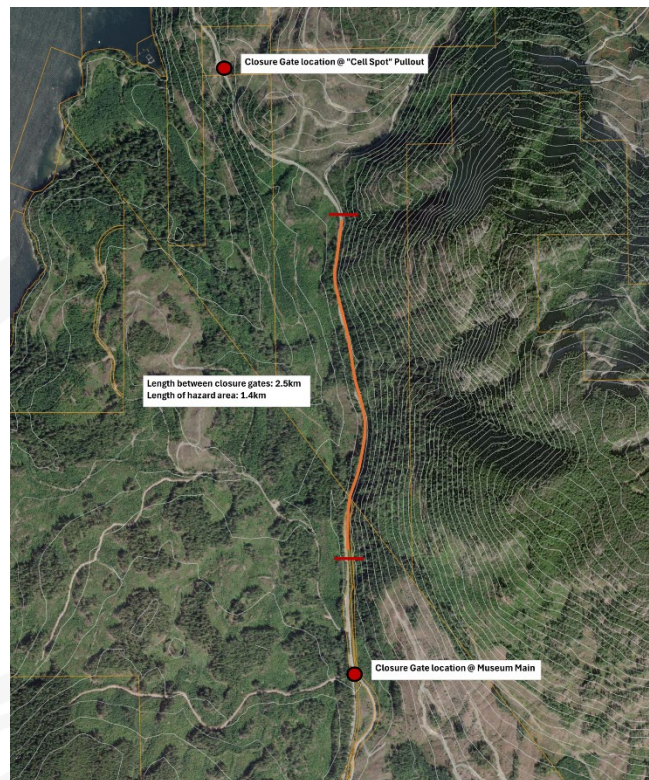

Re: Ministry of Transportation and Transit – Bamfield Road Work Update

The Ministry of Transportation and Transit is actively working towards the safe reopening of Bamfield Road. Current and upcoming activities include:

- Danger tree assessment and removal along the 1.5 km section most impacted by the wildfire. This work began two weeks ago and is expected to continue for approximately three more weeks.
- Procurement and installation of road closure gates at pre-established closure points, providing safe turnaround areas in the event of future proactive closures.
- Installation of a weather station to collect site-specific data on precipitation and wind speed.
- Road base, surface repairs, and signing to follow the completion of danger tree removal.



Subject to weather conditions, all works remain on track for completion by the end of October, which will support the reopening of Bamfield Road.

Further updates will be provided in the coming weeks regarding winter monitoring, reopening protocols, and proactive closure procedures to ensure continued safety for all road users.
