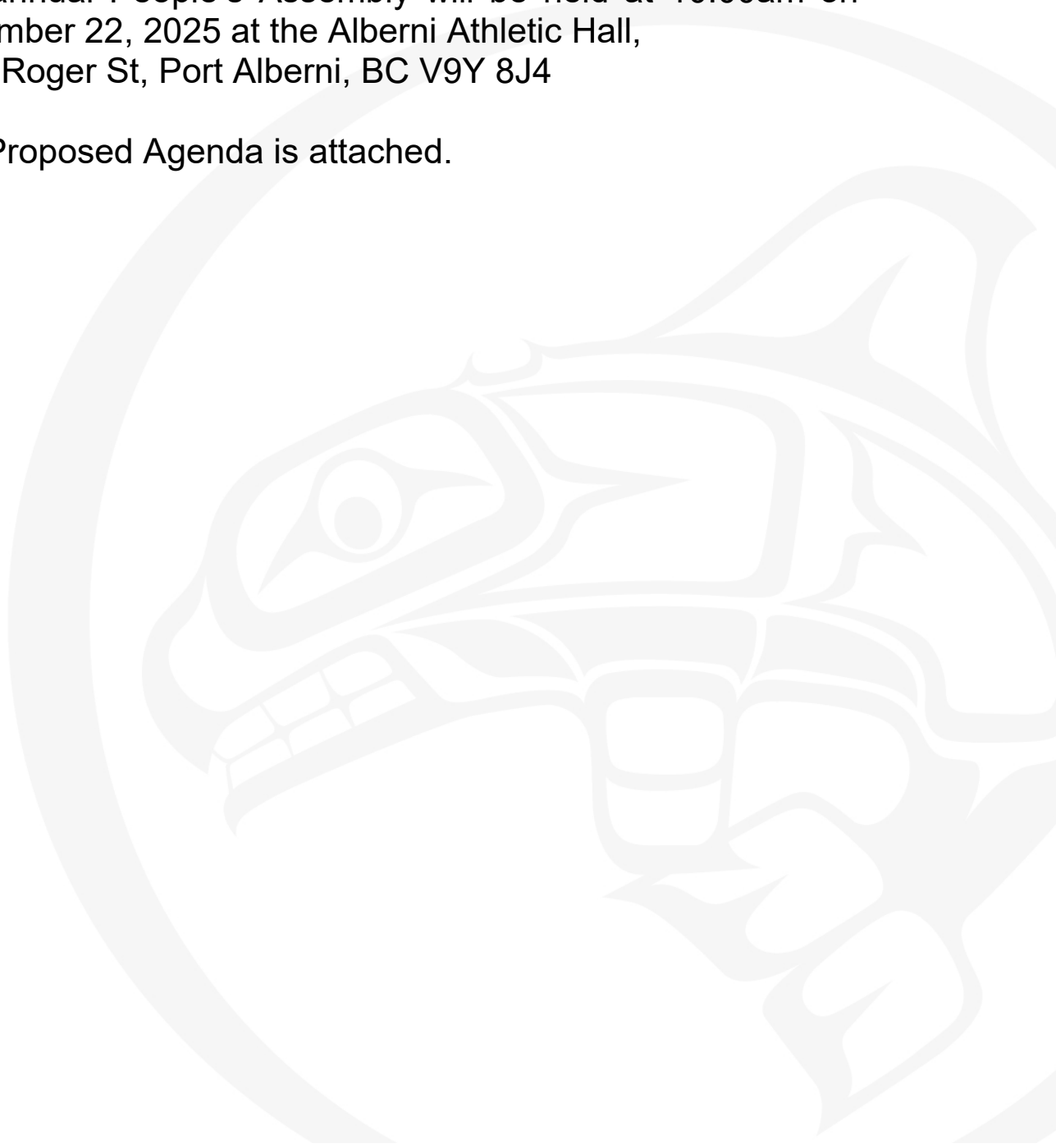

Motion: Recommends to Executive Council to put a policy in place to have administration work with forest companies to allow Huu-ay-aht administration to transport food, citizens to their medical appointments and other items from Port Alberni through any detours.

5. Police Presence in Anacla- Kiana Mio

Motion: Recommends to Executive Council to explore having updated procedures for Witwak to assist citizens with contacting police and bridging the gap on reporting * Executive Council to allocate funds to explore training for Witwak to intervene when necessary * Training to be conducted with the RCMP, Indigenous RCMP and dispatch on protocol and jurisdiction in community; and * Increased communication / interaction with the community from the RCMP on the reporting process and relationship building.
