Now that the Framework Plan is done, we need to update our regulations to allow for the Vision to take flight!!

That is why we’re launching the **Huu-ay-aht Land Use Regulations Amendments Project** - an important step forward for our community that will allow us to unlock the wealth of the Hahuuli and bring our people home.

The Project will be lead by the Lands & Natural Resources Department, with the help of the the Firelight Group, and will update the following Regulations:

1. **Land Use Plan Regulation:** This document sets out our long-term vision for land use and development within our řahuuři, and all other regulations have to match it.

2. **Zoning Regulation:** This document sets the guidelines for what kind of development can happen where, and how each property can be used and built on.
3. **Development and Building Permit Regulation:** This document explains the steps applicants need to take to develop lands in our hahuuli.
4. **The Residential Lease Regulation:** This document explains the steps required to establish residential leases on our hahuuli.

Soon there will be opportunities for you to lend your voice and help shape the regulations throughout the project!

There is much to do! We expect the project to be completed April 2026. Over the next year, we will host a series of virtual and in-person citizen engagement opportunities with the goal of reaching out to and hearing from as many citizens as possible. We will also share project updates openly and regularly to spotlight how your input is helping shape the proposed amendments—ensuring they reflect the real needs of our citizens and their daily lives. There are several ways to stay informed and get involved, including:
